
About the books (Launched on 18 April 2013)

LANDMARKS **MISSION : NATURE-SUSTAINING LIVING**



Divya Prerna Foundation in the past FOUR years of operation has successfully executed 10 Projects in pursuit of its Mission to promote Nature-Sustaining Living. It brought the benefits of Solar Energy to Public Access Locations like Schools, Hostels, Tribal Villages, Medical Center & places of worship etc. by establishing Solar Lighting Systems, using state-of-the art technology in typically Rural/Semi-Urban areas. Let us visit these Landmarks!

P-01, (11 Dec. 2011) TN Govt. Higher Secondary School, P.V. Kalathur, Kancheepuram District TN

Pon Vilaintha Kalathur is a village in Tamilnadu, about 80Kms from Chennai, and close to Chengalpet. It boasts of a legendary past, being the birth place of the famous Tamil poet Pugazhendhi pulavar, and sanctified by the visit of the Great Vaishnavite Savant Shri Vedantha Desikar. The TN Government higher Secondary School named after Pugazhendhi Pulavar, has over 2000 students drawn from many villages nearby. The frequent power outages make studies by the students at home and, at school a trying task.

Divya Prerna took this as the FIRST project in its Mission & engineered a DC Solar Lighting Solution to light the School-Computer Room & Office Room by installing a Solar System. To ensure that the children could read at home, DPF provided 10 Portable Solar Lanterns to bright students of senior classes, selected by the School Management. The School System provides for a Charging Panel for these lanterns, and, the students bring their Lanterns to School, and put them on charge.

While leaving the school they carry their fully charged Lanterns, providing their homes light at night and for them to study!

Look at the 10 bright boys & girls with their Solar Lanterns, presented to them in a function by Divya Prerna in the village on 11 December 2011.



P-02, (11, Dec 2011) Shri Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy Temple, PV Kalathur, Kancheepuram District TN, the SECOND Project-was engineered & commissioned in the ancient & celebrated temple of Shri Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy in the same village, lighting up the praahaaram or the courtyard as well as the Sanctum of the Temple,



to ensure that worship & rituals are performed uninterrupted for the benefit of the devotees. The temple priest & manager were also given Portable Solar Lanterns.

The devotees are delighted about the Solar Lighting System, as it helps in peaceful & undisturbed worship of the deity even after sunset.

P-03, (26, Apr. 2012) CORD Community Centre, Siruvani, Coimbatore, TN.

The THIRD Project DPF took up was in the Coimbatore District, in a village called Thennamanallur, about 35 Kms from Coimbatore city. Chinmava Organisation for Rural Development (CORD) runs a Medical cum Community Center in Siruvani, for the benefit of the villagers, DPF established a Solar Lighting System providing lights for the Doctor's Consultation Room, Operations Room, Typing & Tuition Center, Community Room, and the Central Courtyard.

The system was inaugurated on 26 April 2012, with DPF Managing Trustee presenting 3 Portable Solar Lanterns, to the Tuition Center, and to deserving students of the village.



Dr. Meera Krishna, in charge of CORD, Siruvani, later in her feedback message on 06 Dec 2012 says "Thanks to your generosity, we are able to stretch our days at work and children are able to play, study, and train for cultural programmes. I am attaching a photo of them dancing by the Solar Light and the patients being attended to in the Medical Center."



P-04, (07 Feb 2013) P.U. Elementary School, Tribal Village Kodaikkanal Hills, Dindigul District TN.



This tribal village named SIRUVATTUKKADU is about 22 kms by road up on Kodai Hills, has no last mile connectivity. This village was not electrified and DPF engineered a Solar Lighting System to provide lighting for the School premises, along with 2 sun-sensitive

LED outdoor luminaries for the school front vard. While the classrooms

are lighted, the front yard is automatically lighted at sunset, with the OD luminaries, for the children to study and play, also as a community center for the villagers at night.

DPF presented 10 Portable Solar Lanterns to the students, which can

be charged in the School Solar System during school time & taken home for study at night, as also to help in their movements in the hill areas, after sunset.

P-05, (19 Dec 2013) P.U. Elementary School, Tribal Village Kodaikkanal Hills, Dindigul District TN.



This Project was triggered by the earlier one, with the Primary School in another unelectrified Tribal Village named KALLAKINARU requesting us to provide a similar system. This village is about 40 kms from Vathala Gundu up on the Kodai Hills, with no last mile connectivity. The

Solar System provided by DPF was similar to P-04 with school premises lighted, and 2 sun-sensitive outdoor luminaries automatically lighting up the front yard after sunset. 10 Portable Solar Lanterns were also presented to the children.

The Solar System equipments had to be manually carried up the hilly terrain to reach the village school, for the last 2 miles, by SELCO technicians and villagers.

P-06, (27 Feb 2014) Easwaran Kovil, Vilacheri, Madurai, TN



This ancient temple in Vilacheri a suburb of Madurai, was renovated a few years back but had no proper electric connection DPF rose to the request of the temple trustees to provide solar lighting system to ensure conduct of rituals and worship by the devotees after sunset.

The interior of the temple were lighted by 4 DC LED lamps and 4 powerful outdoor luminaries light up the outer periphery of the sanctum. The Temple Trustees invited DPF to inaugurate the system on the auspicious "Shivaratri" day on 27 Feb 2014. with a "Pradosha Pooja" for the



deity Kasi Viswanathar. The large congregation of devotees were highly appreciative of the Solar Lighting System presented by Divya Prerna.

P-07, (21 Aug 2014) Shri Rama Temple, Vilacheri, Madurai, TN

This Project is also part of Vilacheri Village. This Shri Rama Temple as per stone inscriptions in the premises, dates back to year 1406 AD (more than 600 years old) and the Trustees, during renovation requested for Solar Lighting System from DPF, as they did not have a proper electric

connection. DPF acceded to their request and provided the Solar Lighting System, similar to the Shiva Temple.

The system provided for 4 DC LED lights to light up the interiors of the Temple, 4 OD luminaries to illuminate the outer periphery of the temple, and an additional indoor lighting for the Kovil Kitchen.

The devotees were grateful for the enlightening contribution of Divya Prerna to the temple renovation and worship.

P-08, (19 Nov 2014) P.U. Elementary School, Tribal Village Kodaikkanal Hills, THENI District TN.



This project in the Panchayath Union Primary School in Shriram Nagar in Genquvarpatti, Periakulam Taluk of Theni district was executed after due approvals from the Education Department of Govt of TN, and with their participation in the Inaugural function.

The Solar Lighting System provided for 8 DC LED lamps for the classrooms. 1 for the corridor and

OD one luminary to light up the access the Toilets.







The assembled villagers, students & teachers as also the DPEO of TN Government, praised the beneficial donation of DPF to the School

P-09, (24 Mar 2015) Girls Orphanage, Thirunagar, Madurai, TN.

This project was carried out for the benefit of the orphanage "Balar Illam", being run by the Guild of Service, Madurai for their Girls Home

in THIRUNAGAR. Madurai. It is located in a big campus and accommodates about 100 girls, studying in nearby schools.

The Solar System provided by Divya Prerna included 6 ID LED lights for the Study and Activities Hall, 3 powerful OD streetlight luminaries to light up the outer surroundings



of the Hostel. The girls were also presented 4 Portable Solar Lanterns to



facilitate their movements at night. Madurai Guild of Service also participaed by contributing to the cost of OD luminaries.

The Trustees of Madurai Guild of service and the inmates cherished the solar lighting system provided by DPF and, expressed their sincere thanks.

P-10, (24 Sept 2015) Girl's Hostel, Karadikkal, Madurai, TN

This Landmark TENTH Project was also triggered by the preceding Project. During the inauguration of P -09 the Trustees of The Guild requested DPF to visit their Girls Hostel in KARADIKKAL, where the power situation is more serious & requested DPF to provide a Solar System there also.



After inspection of this Girls Hostel having more than 200 inmates, the



trustees of DPF accepted the request. This Solar System provided for 6 ID LED lights, 2 powerful OD luminaries & 8 Portable Solar Lanterns. Madurai Guild of Service participated in the project by contributing to the cost of OD luminaries and, the Inner Wheel Club of Chennai (Women's Wing of Rotary Club) Contributed the cost of 6 Solar Lanterns.

The girl inmates, School HM, & the Trustees of Madurai Guild of Serivce were delighted with the Solar System, and expressed their thanks to DPF by a joyous celebration in the Inaugural function held in the campus, on 24th Sept 2015.
